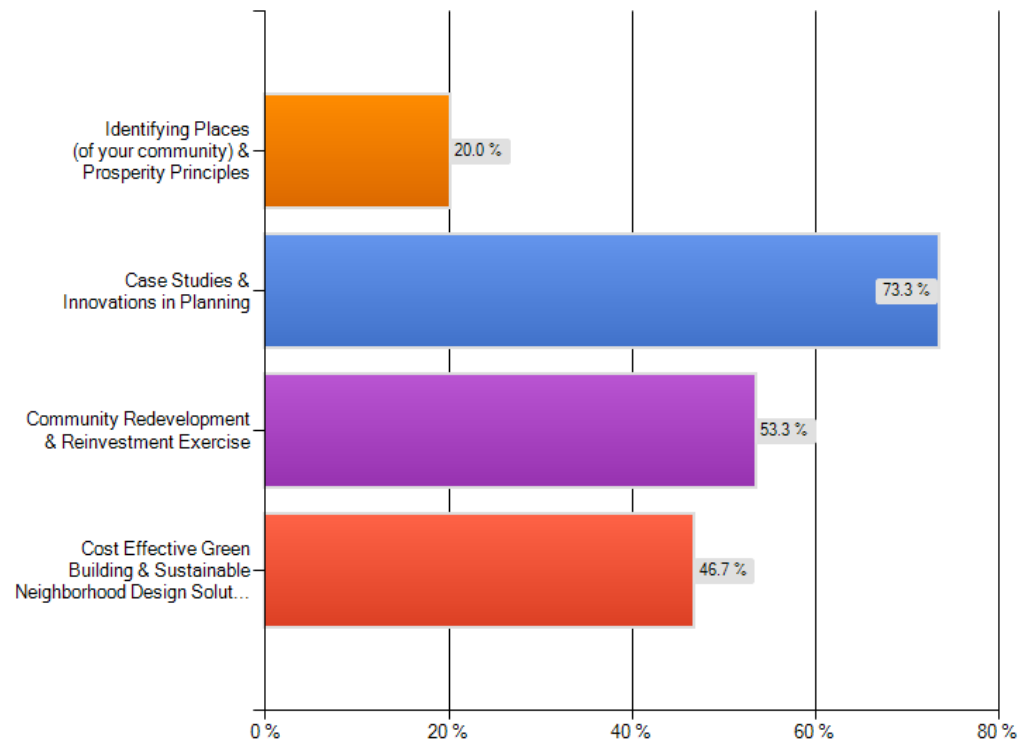

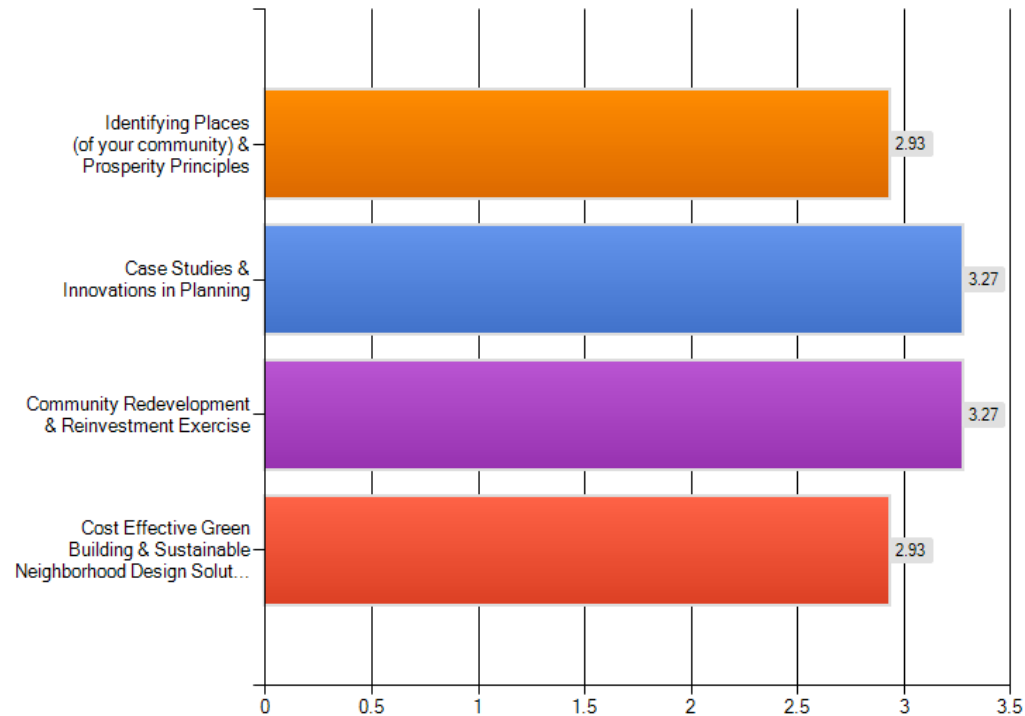

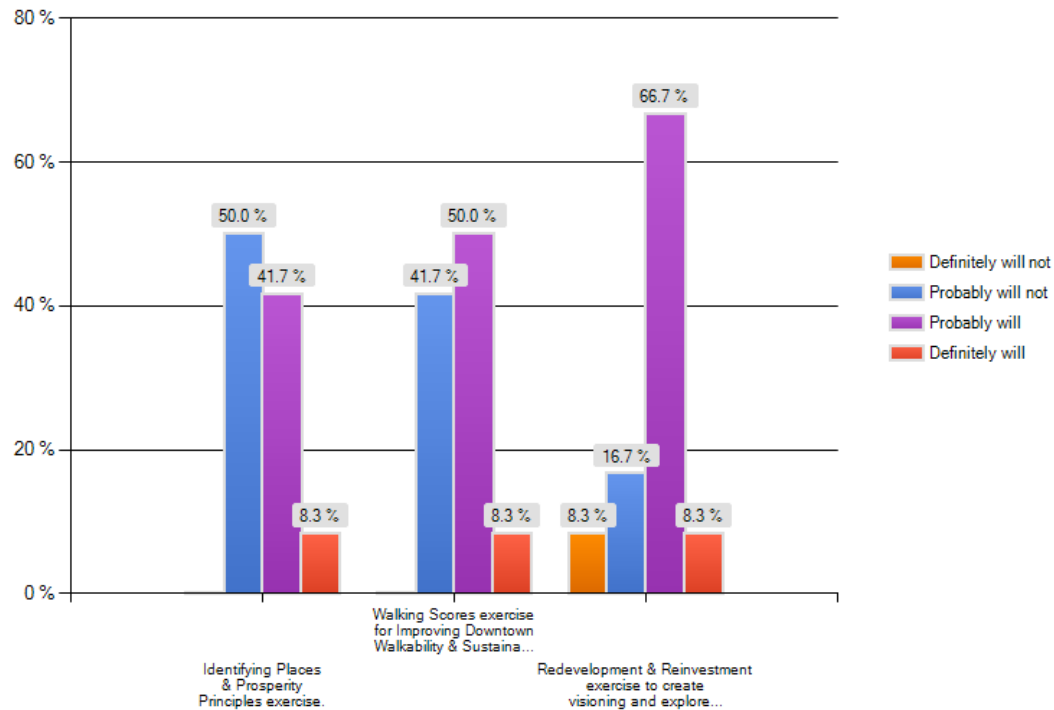
### **I plan to use the information from the workshop by .....**
