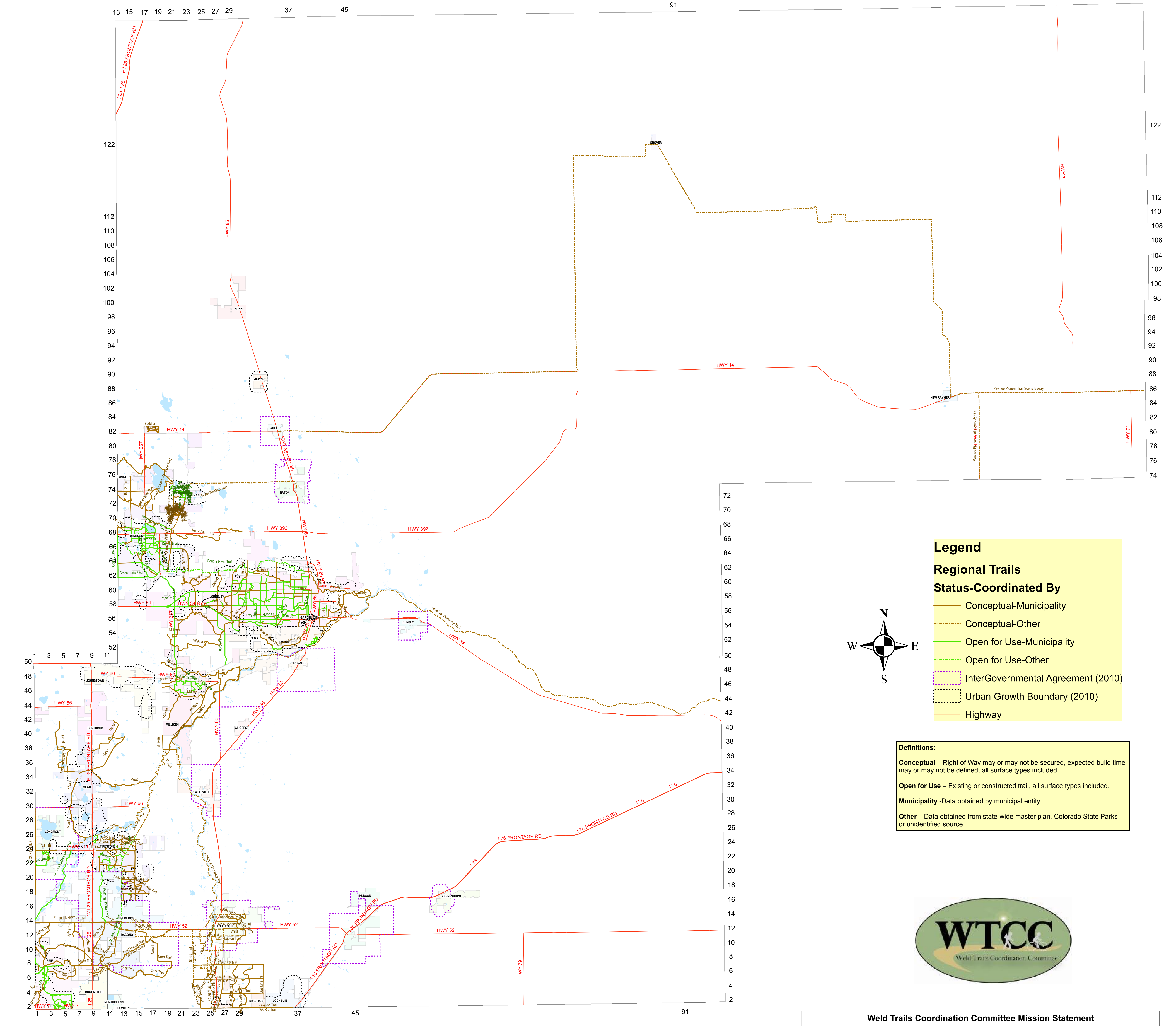


Trails Inventory Map 2010 - Weld County

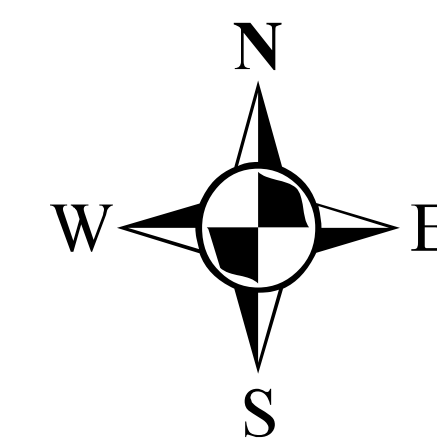

The Weld Trails Coordination Committee is a group of governmental and elected officials, and community organizations who represent all corners of Weld County. WTCC functions as a catalyst to influence the creation of a regional guideline document that offers common language to promote a system-wide, trails master plan for Weld County.
